Selection and notification of awards will be completed by eve of the graduating year. Students will be asked for proof of registration and will need to enroll in a minimum of 12 units in order to obtain their scholarship funds.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, students must:

Complete the following application which includes student/college information, parent-student authorization, accomplishments, and and essay question. Applications will be available upon request from an active member of IEMC. Application must be typed. No exceptions.

Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation. One (1) must be from a teacher. The other may come from an employer, clergy member, community leader, or family friend. The two letters must be attached to the application.

Have a minimum cumulative overall GPA average of 3.0

Attach an unofficial transcript

Please do not attach any information/documents that have not been requested (notebooks, folders, or envelopes). The stapled packet is all that is needed.
